Sarah Rolls and Yordanka Kavalova previously attended the LLP close out meeting. 	In providing LLP report feedback to the Governors Ed Dawson highlighted the key action points for each school: WHJS Improve the consistency of teaching and learning by ensuring best practice observed is fully embedded across all classes and identified staff are building on the knowledge and practice of the most effective teachers in the school. Ensure consistency in marking and feedback so that all children receive the feedback that they need to make the next steps in their learning and ensure that opportunities are created for children to act on this feedback Develop greater levels of pupil independence, ensuring children take responsibility for their learning. Develop the leadership capacity of middle leaders to further impact on outcomes in their subject areas.

- Embed recent improvements in phonics provision to ensure that outcomes in this area continue to rise.
- Develop the leadership capacity of middle leaders to further impact on outcomes in their subject areas.
- Ensure tasks are closely matched to the needs of pupils, particularly in Year 2, to ensure children have internalised key learning.
- Embed the new synthetic systematic phonics programme across the school, ensuring consistency and fidelity.

In summary Ed Dawson acknowledged significant improvements and developments have been made across both schools since the last LLP visit. These have been driven by the EHT and Deputy, who demonstrate a sustained commitment to ensuring the best outcomes for children across the school. Combined with a good understanding of the strengths of the school, informed by monitoring activities, and an accurate appreciation of the next steps that need to be undertaken to move the school forward.

Ed Dawson confirmed his view that with the new senior leadership team and organisation established the school is well placed to continue making improvements that will drive the best outcomes across both schools.

Safeguarding

Following Ed Dawson's feedback PD took the opportunity, whilst other Governors were present, to raise two points re safeguarding.

- The schools have decided via the recruitment process to adopt social media checks.
 This will reflect best practice. It will also be built into the SCR (Single Central Record) checks.
- PD reiterated the need for Governors to have confirmed they have read and understand KSIE (September 2022). Evidence of confirmation has been established via a Google Form, this confirmation will be added to declarations in Gov Hub.
